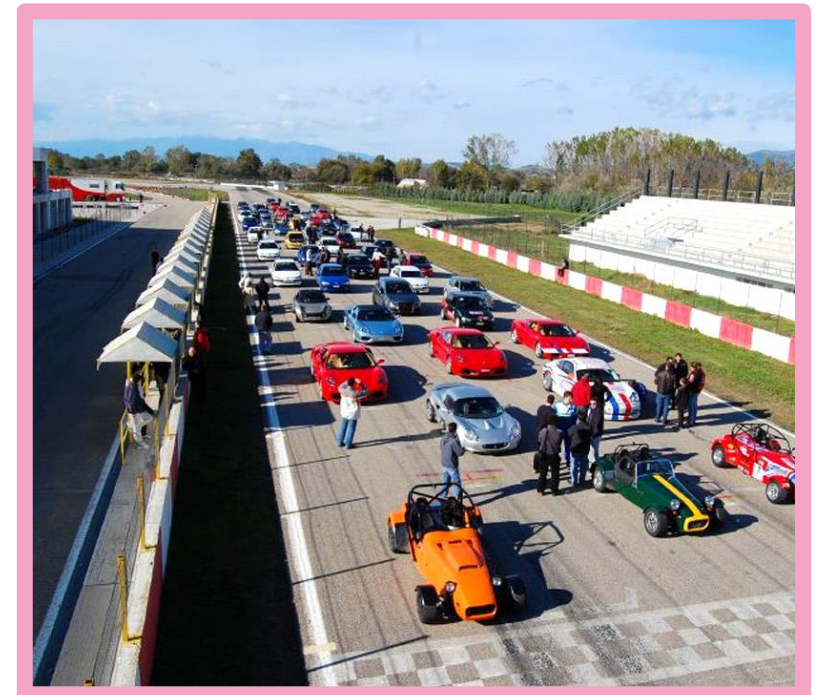
Serres Motor Racing Circuit

The Serres Motor Racing Circuit is the largest track in Greece and has been in operation for over 20 years. Throughout its operation, it has hosted many car and motorcycle races as well as non-racing events and has been characterized as the center of motorsport in the country. You can visit the venue and learn more about motorsport. Additionally, it also operates a Track Simulator, which is often used in traffic education programs.

Destinations in Serres region

Kerkini Lake (30 minutes from the city of Serres)

Created in 1932, when the dam was built in the area of Lithotopos, Struma, and later used as a water storage for irrigating the plain of the region. The riverside forests, the water lilies, and the variety of fish are admirable, serving as a source of income for many locals in the area. In coordination with the Kerkini branch, educational activities, visits, and tours can be organized at the lake.

Roupel Fortress

(on the border with Bulgaria, 40 minutes from the city of Serres)

Roupel, as a fortress, had the most significant contribution to the Greco-German War. It was surrendered on April 10, 1941, but until then stood as a symbol of Greek resistance. Today, it is considered unique throughout Europe. The gorge of Roupel has a length of 11 km and a width ranging from 500 to 2000 m. Its underground chambers are located 17 m below ground and extend for 6100 m, featuring many tunnels and hidden exits. It is considered the largest of the 21 fortresses that make up the «Metaxas Line».

Alistrati Cave (40 minutes from the city of Serres)

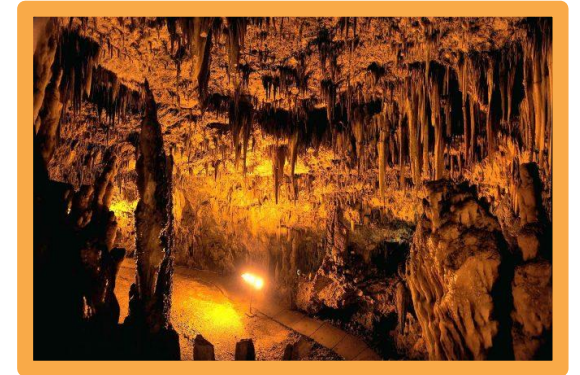
One of the most beautiful caves in Europe. Located just 50 km southeast of the city of Serres, with an incredibly scenic 3 km route, 60 meters below ground, available for exploration. Besides visiting the cave, a complete environmental education program can be implemented.

Another innovation of the cave is Persephone, the world's first robot-guide, which autonomously moves, answers questions, and offers visitors a unique and unforgettable experience.

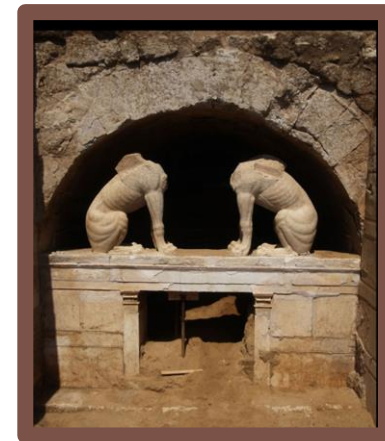
Amphipolis Museum (45 minutes from the city of Serres)

The Amphipolis Museum is a multifaceted complex of spaces and human resources with many different functions related to the protection and promotion of antiquities. In the museum's exhibition, one can learn about the historical trajectory of the ancient city and its immediate surroundings. Its storage facilities and laboratories ensure the preservation, maintenance, and study of the finds brought to light by archaeological excavations. Near the museum is the Kasta Tomb.
